

Risk Assessments

The *Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999* requires Employers to undertake "suitable and sufficient" Risk Assessments of their operations to quantify the risk to Employees and other people affected by the operations (such as Contractors, Visitors, General Public etc.).

TGF offers a service to undertake Risk Assessments. This can be by a combination of observation, digital recording, interviews and a review of existing documentation.

In producing Risk Assessments TGF follows the Health and Safety Executive (HSE) "5 Steps to Risk Assessment" methodology:

1. Identification of Hazards.
2. Identification of persons at risk.
3. Evaluation of Risks arising from Hazards.
4. Recording of Assessment findings.
5. Monitoring and Review of Assessment.

Risk Assessments can be generic in their nature or specific to a particular site or operation depending on Client requirements.

These are initially created in a *Draft* format to allow for formal consultation over the contents and to ensure that they accurately reflect the Company operations.

Increasingly owners (or controllers) of premises are requiring more detailed information and assessments relating to any work undertaken on their sites. This is increasing the burden on our Clients. Therefore, TGF has developed a custom-designed template to allow our Clients to create **Specific Risk Assessments**.

This approach allows those hazards specific to a particular site that our Clients are working on to be identified and assessed to ensure that suitable information is presented.
