Construction (Design & Management) (CDM)

The *Construction (Design and Management) Regulations 2007* introduced specific Health and Safety responsibilities for individuals concerned with construction projects.

- The **Client** has to appoint, and co-operate with, a competent **CDM Coordinator**.
- The **CDM Coordinator** has to coordinate Health and Safety during the design and planning of the project and assess competencies.
- The project has to be notified to the Health and Safety Executive (HSE).
- **Designers** include anyone preparing drawings and specifications such as Architects, Structural Engineers and Surveyors. Designers have to identify hazards and ensure that the design includes a hierarchy of risk control.
- The **Principal Contractor** is appointed by the **Client** to manage and control health and safety during the construction phase of the project. This includes the development of the Health and Safety Plan.

TGF can take on the role of **Advisor** to the **CDM Coordinator or Principal Contractor**.
