

## Fire Risk Assessments

The *Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005* requires Fire Risk Assessments of premises to be undertaken.

TGF can undertake Fire Risk Assessments to comply with the *Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005* and the "relevant Statutory provisions" within the meaning of the *Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974*.

TGF undertakes an inspection of the Client premises and the operations to identify the existing Fire Hazards and current precautions in place.

In undertaking the process of Fire Risk Assessment (FRA), TGF follows steps including:

- Identifying the Responsible Person (the person who has control of or a degree of control of the premises).
- Identifying potential Fire Hazards in the Workplace.
- In the event of a fire deciding who (eg: Tenants, Visitors, etc.) might be in danger (the latter relates to the workplace and escape routes).
- Evaluating the risks arising from the Hazard and judge whether existing fire precautions are adequate or need to be improved.
- Recording the process and the resulting "Requirements" (eg: Assessment Report).
